HOW?

- Have a team parent or team member organize the program.
- Reach out to other students at your school. Hold a school-wide racquet collection drive.
- Ask neighbors, friends, parents, family members, etc... if they have racquets to donate.
- **Collect racquets in season and through your banquet. Deadline to turn in racquets is May 24, 2024.**

WHAT?

WHY?

- Meet individual student community service requirements.
- **Earn money for your team.** Prizes awarded to the boys' and girls' team that collect the most racquets based on the following: \$50 if the top team collects up to 10 racquets, \$100 if the top team collects between 11–25 racquets and \$200 if the top team collects 26 or more racquets.
- All teams that collect more than 25 racquets are eligible to win a case of balls.
